

Eligible Contractual Entity: Current State of Play

- Eligibility requirements
 - Only GSAs for respective subbasin
 - One applicant per basin
 - Compliance requirements
- Roles and responsibilities
 - Numerous administrative, contractual tasks
 - Reimbursement likely to be closely watched
 - Expected to work in service of GSAs
- GSA interest based on discussions to-date
 - Three entities possibly interested
 - Potential for Water Forum to handle as sub to GSA
- GSA board action required by contractual entity
 - Makes near-term decision essential

Eligible Contractual Entity: Today's Discussion

- Revisit/confirm interest among GSAs
- Identify preferred contractual entity
- Discuss parameters between contractual entity and other GSAs; past ideas discussed
 - Administrative Entity works in service of the SGMA Working Group
 - Working Group has direct oversight of all Administrative Entity activities related to grant administration
 - Any changes in scope of work and/or budget outlined in the grant proposal require Working Group review and approval
 - Monthly report from Contractual Entity to Working Group
 - Other ideas....
