

**Cosumnes Subbasin SGMA Outreach Meetings/Briefings
Spring 2019**

This is the first in a series of outreach meetings being held to foster focused discussions with and feedback from the range of water users and uses potentially impacted by GSP development. These meetings, expected to continue throughout the course of GSP development, are intended to complement and deepen feedback gathered via Working Group meetings, public workshops and other outreach efforts.

- Timing: Initial round of 3-5 meetings in late March/Early April 2019 (in advance of public workshops)
- Activity: 3-5 targeted meetings with key organizations across different interest areas (e.g., tribal, wine grape growers, GDE-interested stakeholders, etc.)
- Conveners: Water Forum; support and participation by GSAs encouraged.
- Participants: Suggested participants for an initial round of briefings include (i) Amador County Farm Bureau, (ii) Buena Vista Rancheria and Casino, (iii) EJ Coalition for Water, (iv) The Nature Conservancy, (v) Wilton Rancheria, (vi) E&J Gallo Winery.
- Purpose: (i) Conduct proactive, focused outreach to broaden awareness of groundwater sustainability dialogue and requirements among key interests and stakeholders;
(ii) Present targeted information and engage in focused dialogue with interested entities;
(iii) Seek input on current topics under discussion;
(iv) Determine how entities and their constituents can best engage in the GSP development process;
(v) Support entities in sharing timely and accurate information within their respective networks;
(vi) Identify key issues and interests, to inform the Lay of the Land table (Appendix A of Cosumnes Communication & Engagement Plan).
- Agenda:
1. Overview of subbasin's effort to meet sustainable groundwater requirements
 - Including recent developments (grant funding, work plan, etc.)
 2. Key Interests and Issues
 - This would be an opportunity to discuss the entity/stakeholder group's key interests and issues related to groundwater (to inform Lay of the Land table)
 - Discussion: What are you hearing about SGMA and what are your concerns? What questions can we address?
 3. Stakeholder Engagement and Outreach Plan
 - Overview of subbasin's approach to C&E, including website, upcoming public workshops, Working Group and TAC meetings, email list
 - Discussion: How can the Working Group most effectively engage the entity and its constituents and strengthen its C&E approach?
 - Request for entity to support/augment outreach efforts for upcoming public workshops.

1. Do GSAs want to be part of these outreach meetings?
 2. Do GSAs have suggestions on groups to meet with?
 3. Are we better off meeting with several groups at once or one-on-one meetings?
