

State Launches Listening Sessions to Develop Principles and Strategies Related to Groundwater Management and Drinking Water Wells

The Governor signed the [April 21, 2021 Executive Drought Proclamation](#) after two dry years to prioritize the protection of public health, safety and the environment, and to prepare for and mitigate the effects of drought conditions. Executive Order Action 11 specifically identifies:

“To ensure the potential impacts of drought on communities are anticipated and proactively addressed, the Department of Water Resources, in coordination with the Water Board, shall develop groundwater management principles and strategies to monitor, analyze, and minimize impacts to drinking water wells.”
