*****Monthly Updates*****

Below are brief updates related to SGMA implementation in the Cosumnes Subbasin. To keep Working Group conversations focused on GSP development, we are not planning to cover this material during the October 21 Working Group meeting. However, if there is a topic below that you believe merits discussion with the full Working Group, please let us know and we will do our best to work it into the agenda.

- **Sacramento County Fee Study.** Sacramento County is continuing its work on a fee study. We expect a presentation on the fee study at the Working Group's November meeting.
- **Grants.** Below are several brief updates related to current or future grants:
 - Sacramento County is submitting the first quarterly invoice which includes Prop 68 work.
 - Chelsea Spier with DWR notified John Lowrie, Water Forum, that the TSS application for a multi-completion well in GID GSA has been accepted and hopefully will be constructed next year.
 - No other updates related to the existing Prop. 68 and Prop. 1 grants.
- **ESJ / South American updates.** No WG representatives attended the most recent ESJ meeting. The South American Subbasin will be holding a public meeting November 5 at 6pm. A link to participate in the meeting can be found at SASbgroundwater.org.
- **Dept of Conservation SGMA Watershed Coordinator grant.** Southeast Sacramento County Agricultural Water Authority was to have submitted its Department of Conservation SGMA Watershed Coordinator grant application by Oct 15.
- **Tribal outreach.** Our planning team will work with SRCD to set up a separate briefing with GSAs in late October or early November to discuss tribal outreach with SRCD attorney Holly Roberson. The briefing will discuss SGMA requirements and best practices for outreach to tribal representatives.
- **Tracking Logs.** CBI is working with the Planning Team to develop logs to track Working Group decisions, outreach efforts, and comments from water user. GSAs should be keeping similar logs so the subbasin can comprehensively describe its efforts in its GSP. We expect to discuss these logs at either the November Working Group meeting or with the Outreach & Engagement Committee.
