

Cosumnes Subbasin Working Group
*****Monthly Updates – April 2021*****

Below are brief updates related to SGMA implementation in the Cosumnes Subbasin. To keep Working Group conversations focused on GSP development, we are not planning to cover most of this material during the April 21, 2021, Working Group meeting. However, if there is a topic below that you believe merits discussion with the full Working Group, please let us know and we will do our best to work it into the agenda.

- **Public Workshop planning underway.** The March 24 public workshop was highly attended (approximately 140 total participants) and engaged many new members of the public. The Outreach and Engagement Committee continues to prepare for the next public workshop (scheduled for May 26, 2021). More details will be shared at the Working Group meeting.
- **Tribal outreach.** Several GSA representatives are continuing efforts to strengthen outreach to tribal representatives as GSP development moves into its final year. Letters were sent out to Tribes in late February to determine or reaffirm interest to participate in GSP development. Specific updates will be shared at the Working Group meeting.
- **ESJ / South American updates.** GSA representative are working with the South American Subbasin to schedule a coordination meeting on sustainable management criteria for interconnected surface water on the Cosumnes.
- **Sacramento County Board of Supervisors.** The Sacramento County Board of Supervisors rescheduled its SGMA workshop to May 4. The workshop will cover all subbasins that Sacramento County overlies.
- **Dept of Conservation SGMA Watershed Coordinator grant.** Hiring in progress
- **Grants.** The subbasin's first quarter reimbursement request to the Department of Water Resources is being processed.
- **TSS Well.** No updates at this time.
- **Tracking Logs.** A reminder to GSAs to closely track all outreach efforts within your jurisdiction as this is a key requirement under SGMA.
